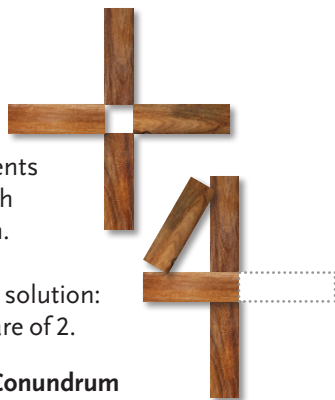

- z = 77 (straight-line numbers)
