The prevaricating paddlers

First, Jean-Guy; second, Dave; third, Klaus;
fourth, Angelo. All statements are false so Dave
beat Klaus (B) and Jean-Guy beat Angelo (C).
Thus either Dave or Jean-Guy came first and
either Klaus or Angelo came fourth. Dave cannot
be first (D), so Jean-Guy was. Klaus cannot be
fourth (A), so it was Angelo. That leaves Klaus
and Dave as second or third. Since Dave beat
Klaus (B), Dave was second and Klaus third.
