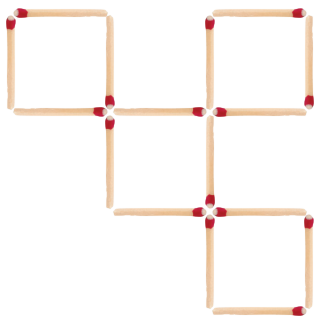
Leaving Caledon East
